

NLR Skin Disease Games - Do-It-Yourself (DIY) version

Memory

- It is recommended to print on thick paper or cardboard.
- Each Memory card has an identical back. So, when you turn over the cards, they all look the same. The backs are displayed on the first page. This page needs to be printed 12 times.
- You can either make a two-sided print or glue the front and the back together.
- There are cutting lines printed on the pages. Follow these to ensure the correct sizes of the cards (74 x 105 mm).
- The orange colour bleeds a bit over the cutting lines, to ensure no white lines appear on the side of the cards; i.e. you will need to cut a small line of orange off each card.

How to play

Bullae/large blisters

Large swellings of the skin

that contain watery fluid

- 1. Put all the cards in rows, facedown on the table
- 2. In turns, turn over any two cards
- 3. If they match, keep them if not turn back over
- 4. The person with the most pairs wins the game 5. Too hard? Play with the cards facing up

Dried serum, blood or pus on the surface of the skin


























Round/oval shaped defect or deep sore in skin, with red or yellow base, possibly black/yellow crust


