

NTD Inclusion Score card (NISC) Installation Guide

0 Introduction

This guide outlines the steps for installing the NISC on your computer. It involves two phases:

1. **Downloading the Installation Package:** Obtain the installation package from the InfoNTD website.
2. **Software Installation:** Execute the installation process on your computer. Please be aware that the NISC tool is incompatible with Apple/Mac computers. You will require a Microsoft Windows operating system.

Also, it is important to note that this tool exclusively records your self-assessment data *on your own computer*. No data is transmitted to the internet or any other parties by mail.

1 Download from the website




Click on the “**nisctool.msi**” which will initiate the download of the installation package (.msi) to your computer’s **Downloads** folder.

2 Installation


Navigate to your Download folder using File Explorer, and double-click on “nisctool.msi”



Click **“Next”**



You will have the option to select a different installation folder, if desired. Click **“Next”**



Click **“Install”**. The default installation will place the software in the standard Programme Files folder, for which you may be asked for an approval.

Once complete, a final window will appear.

Click **“Finish”**.

To launch the programme you will find a **shortcut** on your desktop.
